grant of arms licence under the new Arms Rules, 2016 within a period of four weeks from today, which shall be disposed of by the District Magistrate/ District Arms Magistrate, East Champaran, Motihari within a period of twelve weeks from the date of filing of an appropriate application for grant of arms licence.
