2 25-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 31.08.2019 in connection with Sherghati P.S. Case No.406 of 2019 registered for the offence under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of the petitioner but from the residence of one Sanjay Chaudhary. It is further submitted that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and the petitioner has no criminal antecedents, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his



furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Gaya, in connection with Sherghati P.S. Case No.406 of 2019.
