learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 363, 366(A) and 34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

The victim in her statement, recorded under Section
164 of the CrPC, has very clearly stated that she had left her
home on her own volition and she was never kidnapped by the
petitioner. No doubt, victim was minor at the time of alleged
occurrence but considering her statement recorded under
Section 164 of the CrPC as well as facts and circumstances of
the case, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on
furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two



sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned
Chief Judicial Magistrate, Purnea in connection with Rupauli P.
S. Case No. 99 of 2019.
