2 08-11-2019 Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to place
before this Court any basis of her stay over the land in question.

This is admittedly in the nature of a public land.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
before this Court that even if the petitioner is an encroacher, she
will have a right to get notice and be heard before she is
removed from the place in question.



This Court is not ready to accept the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner to the aforesaid extent. In public interest litigations, the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court has been consistently directing the administration to remove the encroachments and keeping the same in mind it would not be appropriate for this Court to entertain this kind of writ application.

This writ application has, thus, no merit. It is dismissed accordingly.
