2 24-10-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 19.08.2019 &
20.08.2019 in connection with Musrigharari P.S. Case No. 71 of
2019 for the offence registered under Sections 30 (a) of the
Bihar Prohibition & Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the
alleged recoveries were not from the conscious possession of
the petitioners. It is further submitted that the petitioners have
been falsely implicated in connection with the present case. It is
further submitted that the petitioner no. 1 has no criminal
antecedent and the petitioner has one case, in which, he has



already been granted bail.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge IInd cum Special Judge, Excise Samastipur in connection with Mushrigharari P.S. Case No. 71 of 2019.
