as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 413 and 414 of the Indian
Penal Code.

The name of petitioner came in this case in
confessional statement of co-accused Guddu Kumar, who was
arrested on the spot but, admittedly, neither petitioner was
caught on the spot nor anything was recovered from his
conscious possession. Moreover, some co-accused persons,
from whose possession stolen motorcycles are said to have
been recovered, have already been granted privilege of bail by
different co-ordinate Benches of this Court. The petitioner does



not have any criminal antecedents.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, West Champaran at Bettiah in connection with Majhauria P.S. Case No. 285/2018.
