2 18-11-2019 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and
the State.

Petitioners seek bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under Sections 30(a) and 38(i) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners
submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this
case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious
possession of these petitioners. Petitioners have no concern
with the seized article. Petitioners have no criminal
antecedent. Petitioners are in custody since 12.08.2019.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case



and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge II-cum-Special Judge, Excise, Araria in connection with Sikty P.S. Case No. m133 of 2019.
