ORAL ORDER

2 05-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 15.09.2019, in connection with Excise Case No. 603 of 2019 for the offenses under Sections 30 (a) of the Bihar Prohibition & Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the alleged recoveries were not made from the conscious possession of the petitioners but from the motorcycle. It is further submitted that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the petitioners have no criminal



antecedent, let the petitioners, above named, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Gaya, in connection with Excise Case No. 603 of 2019.
