2 21-10-2019 Heard both sides.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in Madanpur P.S.
Case No.157 of 2019, registered under Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

The informant got information that the petitioner was
selling liquor and on such raid was conducted but the petitioner
and Mohan Choudhary alleged to have fled away after seeing
the police. 12 litres liquor was recovered from the house of
Mohan Choudhary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
nothing has been recovered from the house of the petitioner. The
recovery was made from the house of Mohan Choudhary.

Taking into consideration the fact that the recovery
was made from the house of Mohan Choudhary and nothing has



been recovered from possession of the petitioner, let petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge (Excise), Aurangabad in connection with Madanpur P.S. Case No.157 of 2019, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
