APP for the State.

Petitioners seek bail in **Pupari P.S. Case No.519 of 2018** instituted for the offence under Section(s) 272, 273 Indian Penal Code and 30(A), 38, 41 of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

It is submitted that there is no recovery of any illicit liquor from conscious possession of the petitioners. From the seizure list, it appears that seizure has been made from the orchard of Rajaram Mahto and *Baithkaa* of Bharat Mahto.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that Petitioners are in custody since 03.10.2018 having no criminal antecedents.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of



the petitioner for grant of bail is allowed. Let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **2nd Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge, Sitamarhi**, in connection with **Pupari P.S. Case No.519 of 2018**, subject to the condition that both the bailors shall be close relative of the petitioner.
