2      03-01-2019                      Heard learned counsel for petitioner and learned  
counsel for the State.

Petitioner, who is in custody, seeks bail in  
connection with Special Excise Case No. 10980 of 2018 arising  
out of Kotwali P.S. Case No. 795 of 2018 registered for the  
offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition  
& Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is recovery of 14.220 ml. foreign liquor  
from the possession of petitioner.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner  
that she is innocent and has committed no offence. She has been  
falsely implicated in this case on basis of suspicion. Petitioner  
has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 18.11.2018.

Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstances of



the case, let the petitioner named above be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna, in connection with Special Excise Case No. 10980 of 2018 arising out of Kotwali P.S. Case No. 795 of 2018, subject to conditions:

- (1) Bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned.
- (2) Petitioner shall co-operate in the trial and shall be represented on each and every date fixed by the court.
- (3) If the petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
- (4) If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offences, after her release on bail the trial court shall take steps to cancel her bail bonds.
