3 03-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Lauriya
P.S. Case No. 128 of 2018 (Sessions Trial No. 472 of 2019),
registered for offence punishable under Sections 302/34 of the
Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further submission is that there is
case and counter case between the parties and both the parties
have received injuries. He further submits that in this case,
earlier, after investigation final form was submitted by the
police. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he is in
custody since 10.07.2019.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the above-named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 9th Additional Sessions Judge, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Lauriya P.S. Case No. 128 of 2018 (Sessions Trial No. 472 of 2019).
