ORAL ORDER

2 11-01-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Islampur P.S. Case No. 379/18, disclosing offences under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition of Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of huge quantity of liquor from the pick up van parked in front of the house of the petitioner and the said liquor alleged to be of the petitioners.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioners is that they have no criminal antecedent and have falsely been implicated in this case only because the vehicle from which huge quantity of liquor has been recovered, was parked in front of the house of the petitioners and except that there is nothing against the petitioners.

Heard learned A.P.P. also.



Having heard both sides, considering the submission, as above, this application is allowed. Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within six weeks, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 6th Additional District and Sessions Judge cum Special Judge Excise, Nalanda, Biharsharif, in connection with Islampur P.S. Case No. 379/18, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
