2 27-11-2019 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner is languishing in custody since 19.08.2019
in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section
414 of the IPC.

The prosecution case is that from the house of the
petitioner, one stolen motorcycle was recovered.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
recovery has been made from the joint family house. Moreover,
investigation has already been concluded. A statement has been
made in paragraph no.3 of the petition that the petitioner is not
having any criminal antecedent.

Learned APP submits that recovery of stolen motorcycle
has been made from the house of the petitioner.



Considering the nature of recovery, period under custody and fact that the investigation has already been concluded, coupled with the statement made in paragraph no.3 of the petition that the petitioner is not having any criminal antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Katihar in connection with Rautara P.S. Case No. 91 of 2019.
