4 18-11-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail,

arises out of Mahnar P.S. Case No. 272/18, disclosing offences

under Sections 366 and 367 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against the petitioner is that he has taken
the daughter of informant aged about 18 years on motorcycle
and since then, she is traceless.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is
that victim girl had love affair with another co-accused and she
is residing with him and petitioner has falsely been implicated in
this case.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer
for anticipatory bail on the ground that the girl is still traceless.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and
circumstances the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not



inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner rather petitioner has to surrender before the court below and make prayer for regular bail and if any such application is filed, the court below will dispose of the same on the merit of the case, without being prejudiced by this order.

This application is, accordingly, dismissed
