The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in connection with Excise Case No.441 of 2019, registered for offences punishable under Sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

As per the prosecution report, 1093.68 ltrs. of liquor has been recovered from the house of one Surendra Yadav. Petitioner happens to be nephew of Surendra Yadav and they succeeded in fleeing away from the place of occurrence.

Submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has been falsely implicated in this case on suspicion and nothing has been recovered from his house.

Having heard both sides and as he is named in the FIR, I am not inclined to grant privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, however, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned court below and make prayer for regular bail, which will be considered by the learned court below on the basis of the materials against this petitioner and considering the same, let the appropriate order be passed..

With the aforesaid direction, this application is dismissed.
