3 03-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners seek bail in connection with Barahara (Sinha) P.S. Case No. 303 of 2019 (Excise Case No. 1759 of 2019), registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent and have falsely been implicated in the present case. Further submission is that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioners and they have no concern with the alleged vehicle. The petitioners have no criminal antecedent and in



custody since 01.09.2019.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the above-named petitioners be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 4th Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge Excise, Bhojpur in connection with Barahara (Sinha) P.S. Case No. 303 of 2019 (Excise Case no. 1759 of 2019).
