2 18-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

Petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offence punishable under sections 302, 120(B)/ 34 of the Indian
Penal Code and under section 27 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. Nothing
has been recovered from the possession of this petitioner. It
appears from the F.I.R. that cause of death is use of firearm.
From the post mortem report, the cause of death is Hemorrhagic
shock due piercing from sharp object. Petitioner is in custody
since 07.12.2018.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the



petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Session Judge-IIInd, Hilsa, Nalanda in connection with S.T. No. 218/2019, arising out of Hilsa P.S. Case No. 656 / 2018.
