ORAL ORDER

2 15-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in connection with NDPS
Case No. 18 of 2019, registered for the offence punishable
under Sections 8, 2, 20, 25 and 29 of the Narcotics Drugs and
Psychotropic Substances Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner
submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in the present case. Further submission is that
nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner
and he has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner
has no criminal antecedent and is in custody since 26.05.2019.



Learned A.P.P. appearing for the State submits that there is sufficient evidence regarding alleged recovery from the possession of the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, I am not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, this application is rejected with liberty to the petitioner that he may renew his prayer for bail after framing of charge.
