The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered under Sections 279, 337, 338, 304(A) of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 30(a), 56(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution case in short, is that the accused persons dashed one Dwarika Yadav, as a result of which, said Dwarika Yadav died. It is also alleged that 104 litres wine is recovered.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner is in custody since 01-09-2019. It is alleged that 104 liters wine is recovered. So far offence under Section 304A is



concerned, the same isailable in nature. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise, Gaya in connection with Amas P.S. Case No. 169 of 2019.
