the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Ara Mahila P.S. Case No. 76 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under sections 323, 406, 420/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case. As a matter of fact, the negotiation with regard to



marriage could not materialize and therefore in order to put pressure for marriage the present false case has been lodged after about nine months of the alleged occurrence implicating the entire family members. Petitioners have not taken any money from the informant. The allegation is completely false and baseless. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Ara in connection with Ara Mahila P.S. Case No. 76 of 2019 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
