2 11-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the State and learned counsel for the informant.

The petitioners seek bail in connection with Bahera P.S. Case No. 467 of 2018 registered under Sections 341, 323, 324, 307, 354A, 504 and 506 read with 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Considering that the petitioners are admittedly the nephew of the informant and there is case and counter case in respect of the same occurrence and the petitioners having no criminal antecedent have remained in custody for over three years and on completion of investigation, charge sheet has already been submitted, they are directed to be released on bail



on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Benipur, District- Darbhanga in connection with Bahera P.S. Case No. 467 of 2018.
