3 19-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner in this case is seeking anticipatory bail
in connection with Rajgir P.S. Case No.282 of 2019 registered
for the offences punishable under Sections 420, 406, 467, 468,
471 and 120(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this
case. Learned counsel submits that there is no specific allegation
against the petitioner.

Learned APP for the State is present and has opposed
the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case
that this petitioner is neither the executant of the sale deed nor



he has stood as a witness or identifier on the deed and there is no specific allegation that this petitioner had received the money in question, the petitioner having no criminal antecedent, let the provisional bail granted to the petitioner earlier vide order dated 07.11.2019 be confirmed on the same bail bond.
