The petitioners are apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 304(B)/34 of the IPC.

Allegation as per FIR is that petitioners were torturing the deceased due to non-fulfillment of demand of dowry.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner no.1 is the father-in-law and petitioner no.2 is the mother-in-law. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that no specific allegation the against the petitioner and all the allegations are general and omnibus in nature.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the



petitioners, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, I/c, Sitamarhi in connection with Mejorganj P.S. Case No.66/2019, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
