ORAL ORDER

2 13-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case for the offence registered under Sections 30(a), 32(1) and 37(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment) Act, 2018.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 27 liters wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is languishing in custody since 26.09.2019. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. Charge sheet/prosecution report has been submitted in the present case. There is no allegation of tampering with the



witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that total 27 liters wine is recovered from the joint house of the petitioner where other family members also reside. The petitioner was also found in drunken state. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Special Judge, Excise, Patna, in connection with Special Case No. 8633 of 2019, P.R. Case No. 196 of 2019.
