Petitioner has prayed for the following relief:-

“For issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus of any other writ/writs, direction/directions to the respondents authority to release the petitioner from the custody, who has already completed his sentence 14 years and he is ready to pay fine of Rs.50,000/- and his behaviour is good. Whereby and whereunder the petitioner had been convicted and sentenced to R.I. for life and fine of Rs.50,000/- under Section 364A/34 of the I.P.C. in Rahui (Bhagan Bigha) P.S. Case No.49/2003 by Addl. Sessions Judge, F.T.C.-I Nalanda at Bihar Sharif in Sessions Trial No.669A/03 on 05.02.2007.”



Without going into the issue of maintainability of the present petition, Shri P. N. Sharma, learned AC to AG, states that the petitioner's request, which is pending consideration with the authorities, shall be decided expeditiously and not later three months from today, in accordance with law.
