3 18-12-2019 Instant petition under Sections 439 and 440 of Criminal Procedure Code has been moved for grant of bail in F.I.R. No. 287 of 2019 dated 22.09.2019 registered at Police Station Buxar Muffasil under Section 25(1-B)a/26 of the Arms Act.
