2 13-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case for the offence registered under Sections 30(a), 32(ii), 36 and 41(i) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that total 720.360 liters wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is languishing in custody since 05.09.2019. The petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioner. It is alleged that total 720.360 liters wine is recovered from the Tata 407 vehicle. The Tata 407 vehicle does



not belong to the petitioner. The name of the petitioner has come in the present case on the basis of suspicion. There is no compliance of Section 100 Cr. P.C. Other co-accused has been granted bail by this Court vide Cr. Misc. No. 40098 of 2019 under order dated 02.07.2019.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R/ Complaint Case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge-cum-Special Judge, (Excise Act), Darbhanga, in connection with G.O. Case No. 768 of 2018, arising out of Bahadurpur P.S. Case No. 386 of 2018.
