Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Masrakh P.S. Case No. 343 of 2018 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 272/273 of the IPC and Sections 30(a)/38/41 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that save and except the confessional statement made before the police by a co-accused, there is not an iota of evidence to implicate the present petitioner.

In view of the aforementioned facts and circumstances and that the petitioner is having a clean antecedent, let the petitioner above named be released on bail, in



the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned XIth, ADJ Saran / Special Judge, Excise, Saran, Chapra, in connection with Masrakh P.S. Case No. 343 of 2018, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C
