2 27-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking bail in connection with Chandan P.S. Case No. 152 of 2019 registered for offences under sections 20(b) (ii) C/22 of the N.D.P.S. Act.

As per allegation, the vehicle bearing registration no. JH01AV-5124 was intercepted by the police and, on search, 450 gm. of Ganja has been recovered.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that very small quantity of Ganja has been recovered and the maximum sentence for the same is six months.

The petitioners are in judicial custody since 19.08.2019.

Looking to the period of custody, let the petitioners,



above named, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sessions Judge, Banka in connection with Chandan P.S. Case No. 152 of 2019, subject to the condition that (i) one of the bailors shall be a close relative of the petitioners (ii) if the petitioners are found involved in future in similar type of case, the prosecution will be at liberty to make prayer for cancellation of their bail and the court below will pass necessary order, including cancellation of bail and (iii) the petitioners will cooperate the proceeding of the court below. In event of failure to appear on two consecutive dates, the court below will be at liberty to pass the order, including cancellation of bail bonds and (iv) the petitioners will report to the Chandan police station by 7th of every month for at least six months and in case of failure without any valid rhyme or reason, the bail of the petitioner will be treated to have been canceled.
