2 16-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case for
the offence registered under Sections 414, 120(B) of the IPC
and 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise (Amendment)
Act, 2018.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that 3461.04 liters
wine is said to have been recovered.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.
There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged



against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. It is alleged that total 3461.04 liters wine is recovered by the side of the house of co-accused Md. Shamim. The name of the petitioner has come in the present case on the basis of disclosure made by co-accused Rohit Kumar and Jitendra Kumar. Except for this, there is no other substantive evidence to suggest the implication of the petitioner in this case. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner had no knowledge regarding the alleged incident. There is no compliance of Section 100 of Cr.P.C.

On behalf of the learned counsel for the State, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-II-Begusarai-cum-Special Judge, Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016, Begusarai, in connection with Muffasil P.S. Case No. 483 of 2019, subject to the conditions as



laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal
Procedure.
