2 03-01-2019 The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Madanpur P.S.Case No. 213 of 2018 registered under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016 .

Allegation, as per the FIR is of recovery of 38.750 litres of English wine from Tata Indigo vehicle and two persons were arrested there and other two persons were succeeded in fleeing away. Petitioner is named in the FIR.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that petitioner has been made accused only on the basis of confession of co-accused, who has been arrested at the spot but nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and he has no criminal antecedent.

Having heard both sides and in the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, abovenamed, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of order, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge-VII-cum-Special Judge (Excise) Act, Aurangabad in connection with Madanur P.S. Case No. 213 of 2018; subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
