learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with
Sakra P.S. Case No. 227 of 2017 for the offence registered
under Section 392 of the Indian Penal Code.

The allegation is regarding unknown miscreants
having snatched the motorcycle of the informant.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted
that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present
case, no recovery of the stolen motorcycle has been made from
him and no T.I. Parade has been held till date to establish the
complicity of the petitioner in the alleged crime. It is further
submitted that the petitioner is languishing in custody since
25.06.2019.



Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate-IV, Muzaffarpur in connection with Sakra P.S. Case No. 227 of 2019.
