2 16-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case for
the offence registered under Sections 354, 504/34 of the IPC and
67 and 67(a) of the I.T. Act.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the petitioner
alongwith other co-accused took the informant's photo illegally
and sent it on *Whatsapp* and *Face Book*. Due to this reason, the
informant's daughter became mentally sick.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent.
There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged
against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated



in the present case. It is alleged that the petitioner took the photographs of the informant's daughter illegally and put it on Social Media. It is submitted that merely on the basis of suspicion, the name of the petitioner has come in the present case.

On behalf of the learned counsel for the State it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. West Champaran, Bettiah, in connection with Bhangaha P.S. Case No. 33 of 2019, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
