2 28-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel representing the State.

The petitioner in the present case is seeking regular bail
in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No.636 of 2019, Special
Case No.8746 of 2019 registered for the offence punishable under
Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act, 2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case.
Learned counsel submits that there is no recovery from the
possession of the petitioner and he is in custody since 01.10.2019.

Learned APP has opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering that the petitioner is in custody since
01.10.2019 and prior to this case he had no criminal antecedent, let
the petitioner above named be released on bail on furnishing bail



bond of Rs. 15,000/- (fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge, Excise Act, Patna in connection with Naubatpur P.S. Case No.636 of 2019, Special Case No.8746 of 2019, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 437 (3) Cr.P.C. as under:

(a) that such person shall attend in accordance with the conditions of the bond executed under this Chapter,

(b) that such person shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, and

(c) that such person shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any Police officer or tamper with the evidence.
