ORAL ORDER

3 10-12-2019 Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
respondents-State of Bihar does not dispute the petitioners'



contention that their case is covered by the decisions of this Court rendered on 03.10.2018 in CWJC No. 17151 of 2018 and 23.06.2017 in LPA No. 167 of 2016.

This writ application is accordingly disposed of with the same observations and directions as present in the aforesaid orders dated 03.10.2018 in CWJC No. 17151 of 2018 and 23.06.2017 in LPA No. 167 of 2016. Consequently, it is directed that the petitioners shall be paid the benefits in the scale of Rs. 4000-6000 with retrospective effect from the dates of their respective appointment. As observed in the Division Bench decision in LPA No. 167 of 2016, it is observed that the arrears of the petitioners shall be granted with effect from the date they filed the writ application before this Court on 23.11.2019.
