Appellant has preferred this Letters Patent Appeal against the judgment dated 29.08.2019 passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court in C.W.J.C. No. 1073 of 2017, titled as Arun Kumar Jha Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors., whereby District Magistrate, Darbhanga has been directed to remove the encroachment after due notice to the encroacher within a period



of eight weeks of receipt/production of a copy of the order in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the present appeal reserving liberty to file a review application seeking review of the impugned order dated 29.08.2019 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 1073 of 2017, titled as Arun Kumar Jha Vs. The State of Bihar & Ors.
