2 02-12-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections
2,35,22,27,29,31 and 51 of Wild Life Protection Act.

According to FIR the authorities seized two logs of
wood from the forest area and the miscreants allegedly fled
away taking advantage of darkness.



Submission is that the petitioners have been arrayed as accused only on suspicion. They have got no criminal antecedent.

Let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000 (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned court below where the case is pending in connection with Tr. No.3392 of 2019, arising out of I.F.Case No. 90 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure and further the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
