2 04-12-2019 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks regular bail in connection with Chapra Town P.S. Case No. 651 of 2019 for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a)/ 41(i) (ii) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

The allegation is regarding recovery of 34.545 liters of illicit liquor from the rented house of the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. It is further submitted that the petitioner is having a clean antecedent and is languishing in custody since 30.10.2019.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be enlarged on



regular bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned 2nd Additional Sessions Judge cum Special Judge Excise, Saran at Chapra in connection with Chapra Town P.S. Case No. 651 of 2019.
