APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 406,420/34 of the IPC.

The allegation in the present case is regarding the petitioner herein taking money from the informant for the purpose of marrying his son with the daughter of the informant, but subsequently the petitioner refused to marry his son with the daughter of the informant and instead solemnized his marriage with other girl.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that allegation levelled against the petitioner is false and concocted. The learned counsel for the petitioner further submits by a co-



ordinate Bench co-accused has been granted bail vide order dated 23.02.2018 in Cr. Misc. No.1852/2018.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Patna in connection with Digha P.S. Case No.190/2017, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
