Katoria P.S.Case No. 74 of 2018 registered under Sections 379

and 411 of the Indian penal Code and 4 and 21 of the Mines

and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 and 4

and 40 of the Bihar Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 1972.

Allegation as per the FIR is that tractor of the petitioner
was intercepted by the police loaded with sand.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that
petitioner is owner of the tractor and even seizure-list shows that
only small quantity of sand was found in tractor and moreover,
he has no criminal antecedent and is ready to abide by any terms
and conditions imposed upon him.

Having heard both sides and in the facts and circumstances, as stated above, let the petitioner, abovenamed, in the event of arrest or surrender before the court below within a period of six weeks from the date of order, be released on bail upon furnishing bail bond of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned CJM, Banka in connection with Katoria P.S. Case No. 74 of 2018; subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
