ORAL ORDER

2 29-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned counsel for the State.

Both the petitioners have filed the present writ application seeking the relief of mandamus commanding the respondents for re-measurement of the height who are above 160 centimeter and 155 centimeter required by them being BC category and SC category and include their name in the merit list of the constable prepared against the Advertisement No.1/19 for appointment to the post of constable. Both the petitioners



were de-listed from the merit list due to short height about 0.5 cm in the measurement while the height of both the petitioners are above to the required height.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submits that the selection process has already been completed and both the petitioners at the time of measurement of height and physical test were found 0.5 cm short in length as required by their category.

As such, I find no merit in this writ application, accordingly, this writ application stands dismissed.
