Though the petitioner has sought a direction to the authorities concerned for transferring him under the rules to a place of his choice, but during the course of argument, he has expressed that he shall be satisfied if a direction is issued to the District Programme Officer (Establishment), Gaya to dispose of the representation preferred by him in that regard, as early as possible, preferably within a period of three months of the receipt/production of a copy of this order.

3. The District Programme Officer (Establishment), Gaya (respondent No. 8) is directed to dispose off the representation of the petitioner within a period of three months. For the convenience of the petitioner as also of the concerned respondent, the petitioner is directed to file a fresh representation within a period of two weeks from today before the concerned respondent. The date for disposing of the petitioner's representation will start running from the date of the receipt of the fresh



representation.

petition stands disposed off.
