Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the authority under the Act has already passed order on 28.01.2017 (Annexure-3) but thereafter the respondents are bent upon to construct boundary wall, therefore, the respondents be restrained from constructing boundary wall.

Since the matter is under subjudice before the competent authority under the Act, if the petitioner is at all aggrieved by any action of the respondents, the petitioner has



got remedy to file petition before the competent authority.

Having considered the facts, I find no merit this writ
petition and accordingly, the same is dismissed.
