learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
the offence under Sections 341, 323, 324, 325, 307, 504 and
506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that the petitioner, who is of clean antecedent, is
innocent and has not committed any offence. In fact, there is
no specific allegation attributed to the petitioner rather the
specific allegation is against co-accused, Rakesh, Mukesh and
Lakshman and the petitioner is rotting in judicial custody
since 22.09.2019.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the, above named, petitioner be released on bail on
furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of
learned A.C.J.M, Sikrahana at Dhaka, East Champaran in
connection with Chiraiya P.S. Case No. 439 of 2019.
