2 26-11-2019 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
learned counsel appearing on behalf of the State.

The petitioner is in custody since 04.07.2019 in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No.71 of 2019 registered for the offence Section 394 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R., but during the course of investigation, one Md. Shahabuddin, who was arrested by the police and has confessed his guilt, has disclosed the name of the present petitioner. It is further submitted that till date, there has been no recovery from the conscious possession of the petitioner and he has also not been placed on T.I. Parade. It is further submitted that the petitioner is having one other case under Section 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act, in which he has



already been granted bail.

Considering the aforementioned facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail on his furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran, in connection with Gopalpur P.S. Case No.71 of 2019.
