ORAL ORDER

3 02-01-2019 The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance of the petitioner has already been redressed, inasmuch as a direction has been issued by the opposite parties for payment of the benefits of the third A.C.P., however the actual benefit is yet to be received by the petitioner. The learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the opposite parties have stated in their show cause that the payment will be made forthwith, inasmuch as the requisition for the funds has already been sent to the Treasury in order to enable the payment to be made to the petitioner under the head of the benefit to be granted under the 3rd A.C.P. scheme.



Having regard to the submissions made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, the present contempt petition is disposed of as not pressed, however with a direction to the opposite parties to pay the actual benefits to the petitioner, in monetary terms, within a period of 12 weeks from today.
