The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341,323,324,307,504,506/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioners allegedly caused injury at the head of the respective injureds.

Submission is that the Doctor has found simple injury.

Since the petitioners had knowledge that their act might cause death, in my view, this is not a fit case for anticipatory bail. Hence, prayer for anticipatory bail is refused

Petitioners may surrender and pray for regular bail
within two weeks.
