2 25-11-2019 This application, for grant of anticipatory bail, arises out of Naya Ramnagar P.S. Case No. 222/2019, disclosing offences under Sections 30/32 of the Bihar Prohibition of Excise Act, 2016.

Allegation is of recovery of 45 litres of country made liquor from the tempo of the petitioner.

Submission of learned counsel for the petitioner is that he has no criminal antecedent and has falsely been implicated in this case only because, he happens to be owner of the tempo, whereas, the tempo was in possession of driver, who fled away.

Learned counsel for the State opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

Having heard both sides, considering the facts and



circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner rather petitioner may surrender before the court below and make prayer for regular bail and if any such application is filed, the court below will dispose of the same on the merit of the case, if possible on same day, without being prejudiced by this order.

This application is, accordingly, dismissed.
