Under the aforesaid circumstances, the respondents are hereby directed to take appropriate steps for payment of salary for the period the petitioner has admittedly worked.

Necessary decision for payment of salary for the period the petitioner has worked by taken by the respondents within a period of sixty days from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order.

With the aforesaid, the writ petition stands disposed of.
